- 1969 :** Born in Vernon (France) Graduated at Paris Conservatoire with **Dominique MERLET** and **Christian IVALDI**.
- 1994 :** Artist in residence at Côme lake foundation, Italy. Meeting **Leon FLEISHER**, **Murray PERAHIA**, **Karl-Ulrich SCHNABEL**, **Fou T'SONG**, **Charles ROSEN**.
- 1998 :** First recording of Beethoven's «Hammerklavier» sonata. He has been playing «Hammerklavier» so far more than 60 times in concert.
- 1999 :** **François-Frédéric GUY** represented by **Van WALSUM** Management in London until now.
- 1999 :** Brahms piano concerto n°2 with Orchestre de Paris at Salle Pleyel conducted by **Wolfgang SAWALLISCH**.
